

ONLINE MS IN CLINICAL EPIDEMIOLOGY

To apply to the [online Master of Science in Clinical Epidemiology](#) program, follow the steps below.

- Application form:** Start the Kent State application online here: <https://apply.kent.edu/apply/>
- Three letters of recommendation:** These letters must be submitted from academic sources who can assess your academic preparation, abilities and accomplishments (professional sources may be accepted, please speak to an Admissions Advisor). To complete your request for letters of recommendation:
 - Enter your recommenders' contact information on the online application form
 - Select "Yes" when asked if you want to use the online recommendation system
- Application fee:** Submit the \$45 application process fee. This fee may be paid online at the end of the application form.
 - Please speak with your Admissions Advisor for details on whether an application fee waiver applies.
- Official transcripts:** Upload copies of your official undergraduate transcripts (front and back) to the online application, plus transcripts for any graduate coursework or degree(s) you may have earned. You may also send your transcripts via postal mail to the address below:

- Goal statement:** In two pages or less, explain why you are seeking a MS in Clinical Epidemiology and why you chose Kent State University
- GRE scores:** Due to COVID-19 concerns, the GRE requirement has been temporarily suspended for applicants to the spring 2022 term
- Resume/CV:** Professional resume listing your education and progressive professional responsibilities
- Submit Your Application:** Once all required documents have been uploaded and recommenders' contact information has been added, please ensure you "submit" your application
