IF YOU ARE AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

International students must provide proof of English language proficiency with an acceptable score on one of the following tests.

| Test | Minimum score |
|---------------------------------|---------------|
| TOEFL PBT (paper-based test) | 550 |
| TOEFL IBT (internet-based test) | 79 |
| MELAB | 77 |
| IELTS | 6.5 |
| PTE | 58 |
